As this will also be available to temporary visitors and new Attenders as well as Members it has been decided to include a brief description of our groups which all are welcome to attend.

EVENTS

Rawdon Meeting for Worship: every Sunday 10.45am in meeting house.

Rawdon Local Business Meeting: in meeting house after meeting for worship on the first Sunday of certain months. Watch the Diary.

Leeds Area Business Meeting: this happens on a Saturday or Sunday 6 times a year. Watch the Diary.

Rawdon Mid-Week Meeting for Worship: a less formal QMW that provides a space for adding to our spiritual practice, for example a poem or a piece of music is often shared just before meeting. It takes place on Wednesday evenings in Quaker Cottage, next door to the meeting house. Ask Su George.

Sunday Meeting for Worship at Otley: Otley Quaker Meeting is a very small Meeting which invites visitors to attend and support its meetings, first and third Sundays 10.45am, at Otley Courthouse.

Meeting for Worship at Bedford Court Residential Home, Horsforth: Bedford Court holds a Quaker meeting for worship on first and third Wednesdays at 10.30am in the Conservatory. Everyone is welcome. Ask Barbara Parry.

Rawdon Shared Suppers: these take place in Friends' homes every two months on different evenings, beginning at 6pm with a shared meal and followed by consideration of a chosen topic, led by a member or attender of our meeting. Watch the Diary.

Bible Study: a medium-size group who seek to reflect upon the verses of the bible using our Quaker insights and personal experiences as we travel along our individual spiritual journeys together. The group meets every first and third Tuesday of the month, at Carlton Hill QM, 188 Woodhouse Lane LS2 9DX. Everyone welcome, you do not have to have read the Bible before. Ask Lois Gilling or Fiona Pacey.

Experiment with Light: meets approximately once a month on a Saturday morning at Adel QM and once a month at Carlton Hill, seeking to bring the Light into the challenges of our life. It is based on the explorations of **Rex Ambler (Light to Live By)** into the inspiration and meditative practice of early Friends and the psychological focussing techniques of **Eugene Gendlin**. Rawdon Amnesty Concerts: an annual concert series in aid of Amnesty International which runs from May to December. Money is raised by donations as entry is free. Help on the day is joyfully received. Ask Barbara Parry or Diane Exley.
